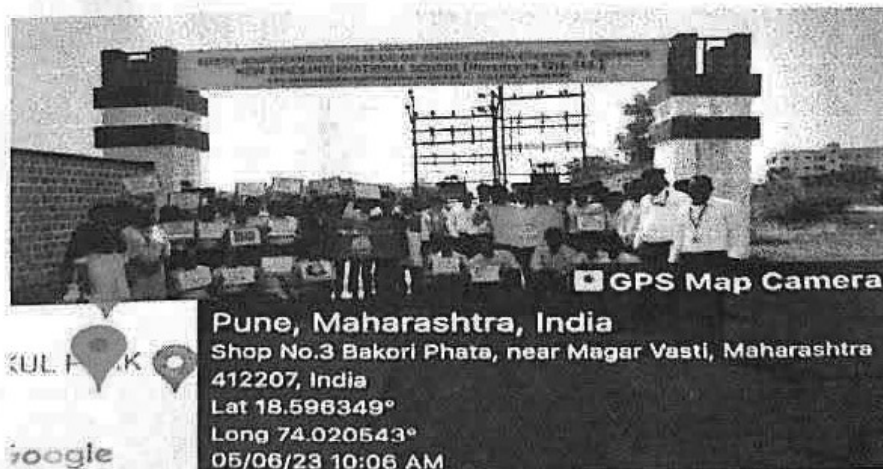
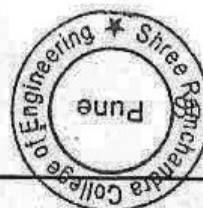
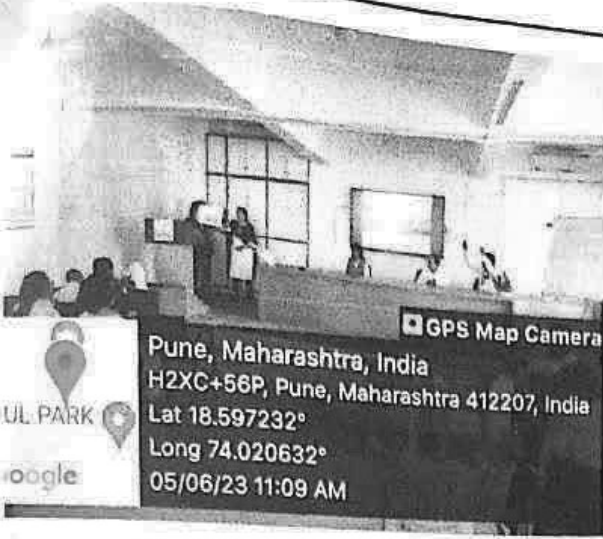


Fig. 1 SRCOE Staff Celebration of World Environment Day 2023.

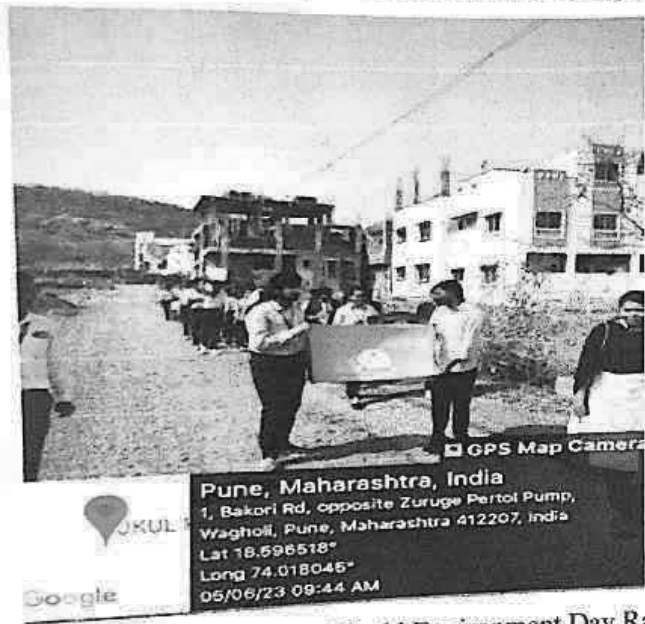

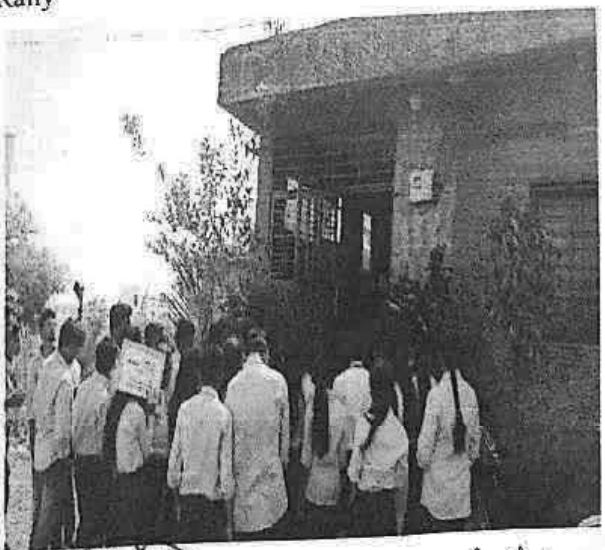
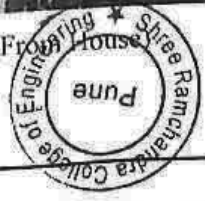


Fig 4 Collection of plastic waste. (From House)



Detailed Summary:-

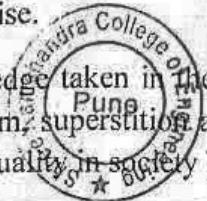

He was a well-known statesman who strived for the upliftment of Dalits and those from socially backward communities

The 132nd Birth Anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar is held to honour the memory of Indian politician and social reformer, with a lot of enthusiasm and energy on Thursday, 13th April 2023 at 10:30 am in the premises of Shree Ramchandra Education Society's, Shree Ramchandra College of Engineering Pune,

The birth anniversary program was conducted in the college so that the students get acquainted with the works and reforms of Dr. Ambedkar. The program was graced with the presence of Hon. some Students delivered a short introductory speech in which she/he told about Dr. B.R.Ambedkar and his remarkable contribution to the society and to the girls education.

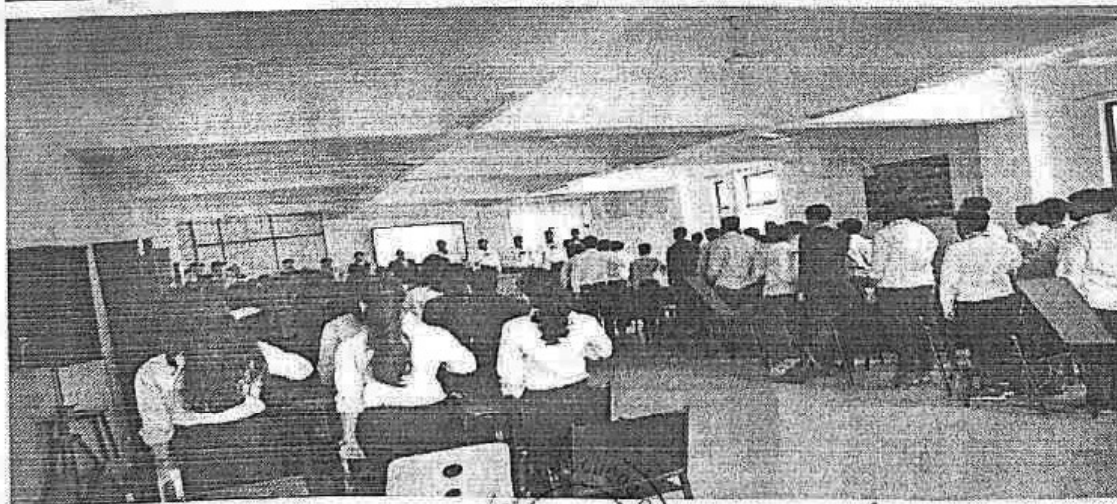
NSS Officer Prof. S.S. Patil delivered his speech on Dr. Ambedkar jayanti celebration.

On 14 April 1990, Ambedkar was bestowed with Bharat Ratna award.

Hon. Chairman Shri Maruti Bhumkar expressed his view on the biggest barrier in Ambedkar life about the caste system according to which the family he was born was considered 'untouchable'. The life of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar, was marked by struggles and he proved that every hurdle in life can be surmounted with talent and firm determination. He is regarded as a **symbol of knowledge** because he holds several advanced degrees, including M.A., MSc., PhD, and others. He extended his views about Dr. Ambedkar as a strong advocate for women's rights and believed that gender equality was essential for India's progress. In 1927, he led the Mahad March at the Chowdar Tank to allow untouchables to use water in a public tank in Mahad (in Raigad district) Maharashtra, India. The temple entry movement launched by Dr. Ambedkar in 1930 at Kalaram temple, in the struggle for human rights and social justice. He conveyed that it is a day to remember this great noble soul and to honor his beliefs, teachings, and works. We must pledge to make India a country as he had once dreamt.

At the end of the program, Vote of thanks was delivered by Prof. Pramod Walunj to the dignitaries, head of the department, teaching and non-teaching staff, students and as well as volunteers for making this event success and remember-able.

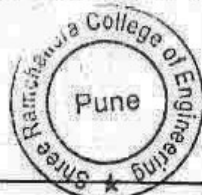
Detailed Summary:-

3. Quiz Competition.



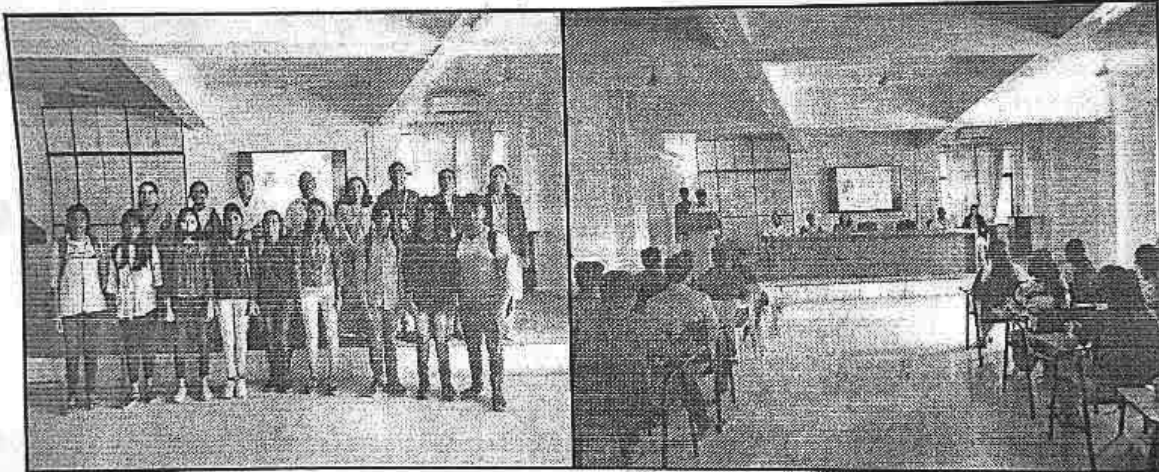

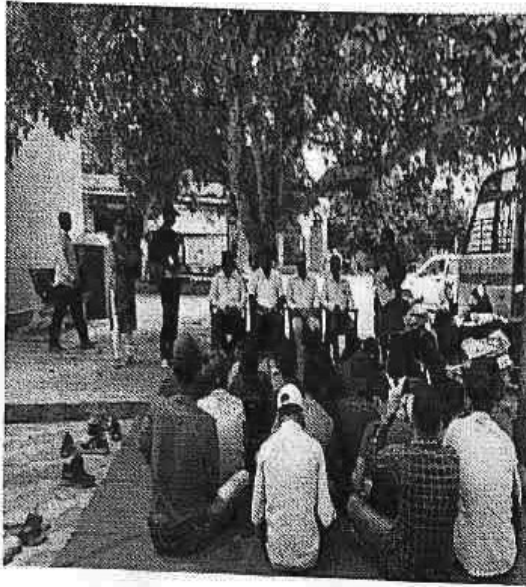
Day 1- (17th March 2022)

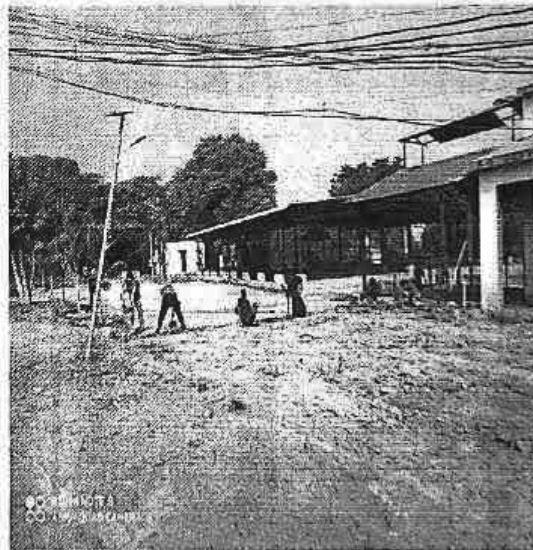

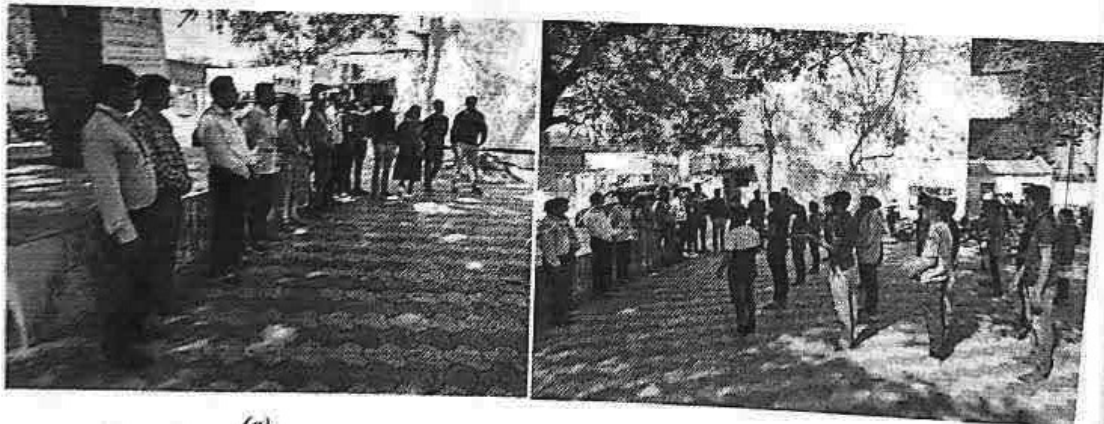

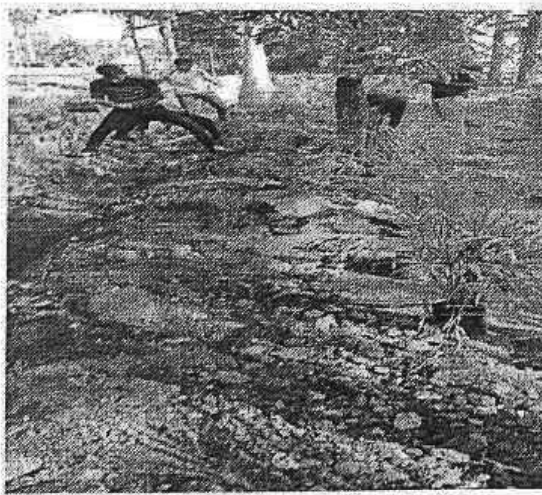

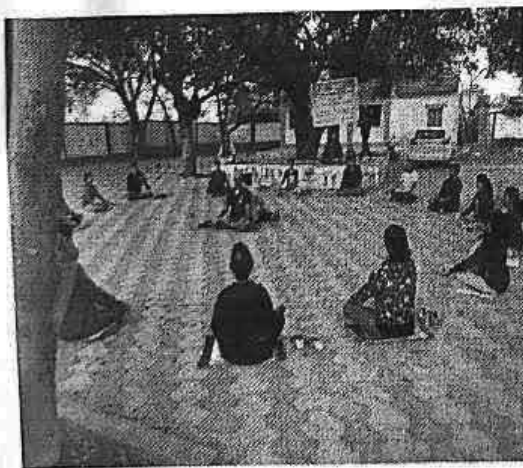

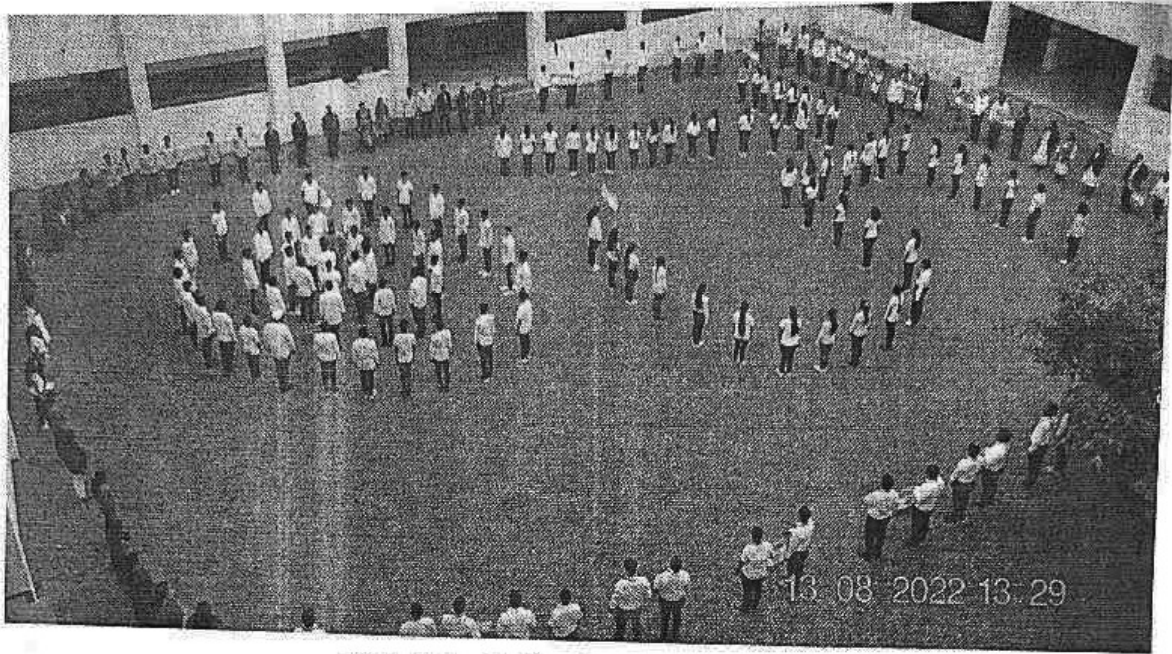

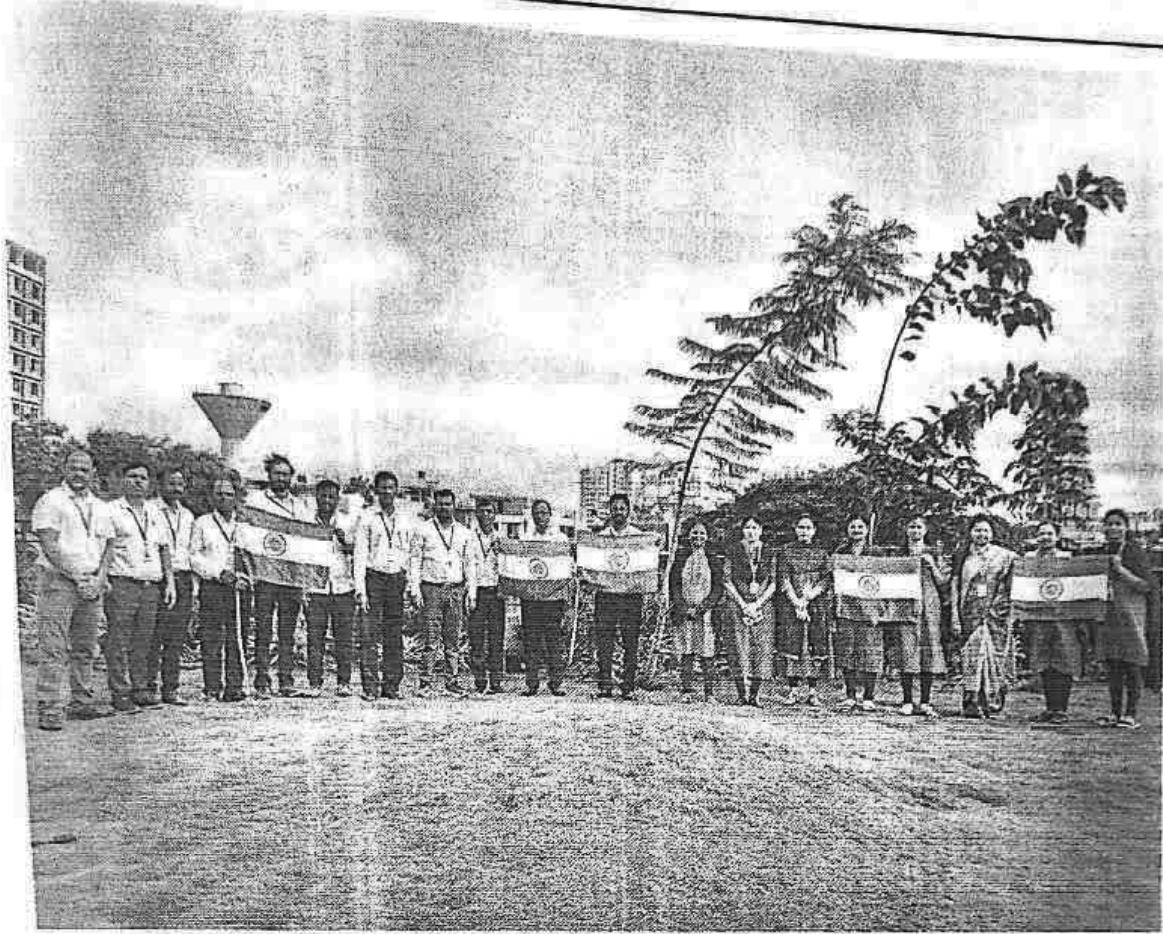

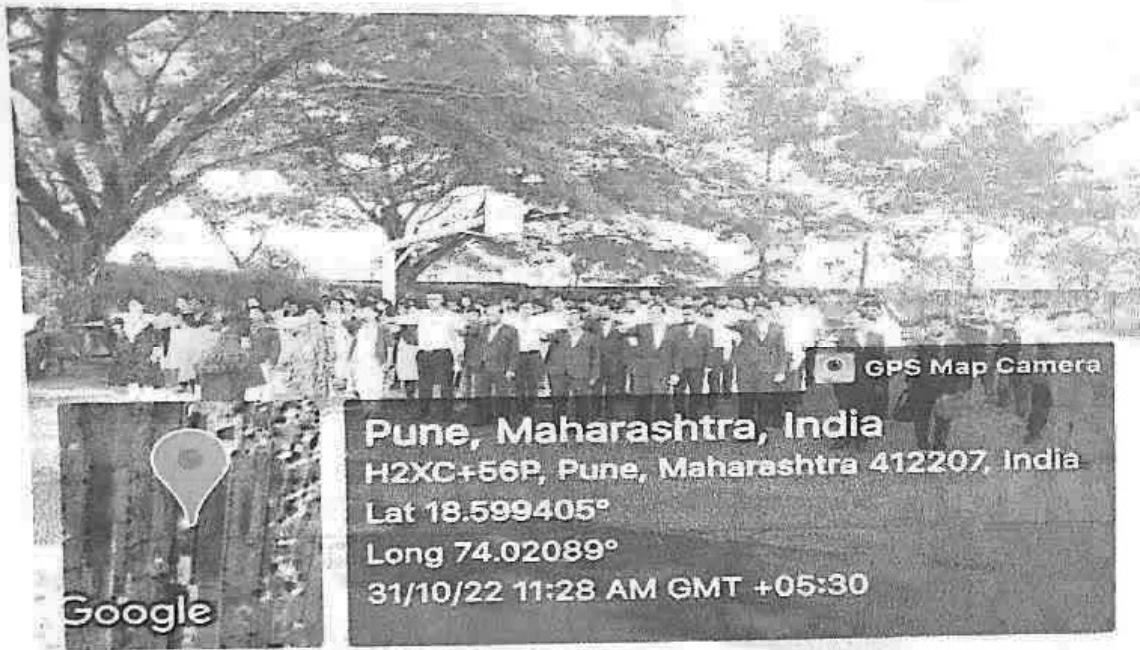


Fig.2 Rashtriya Ekta Diwas Pledge

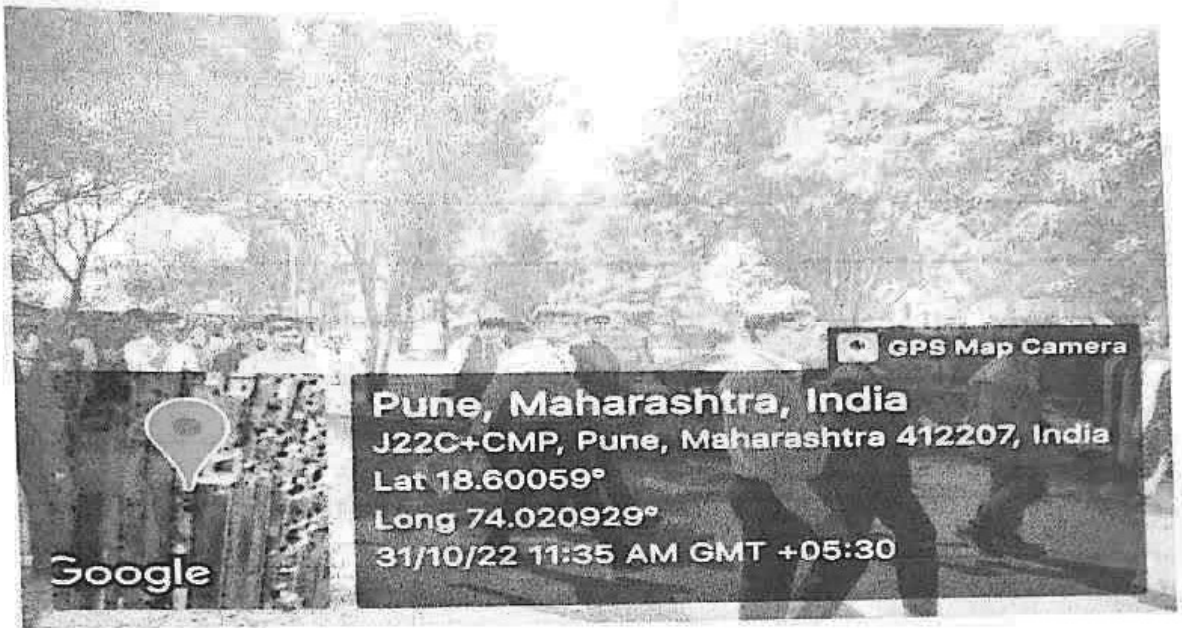


Fig.4 .Run for Unity Rally

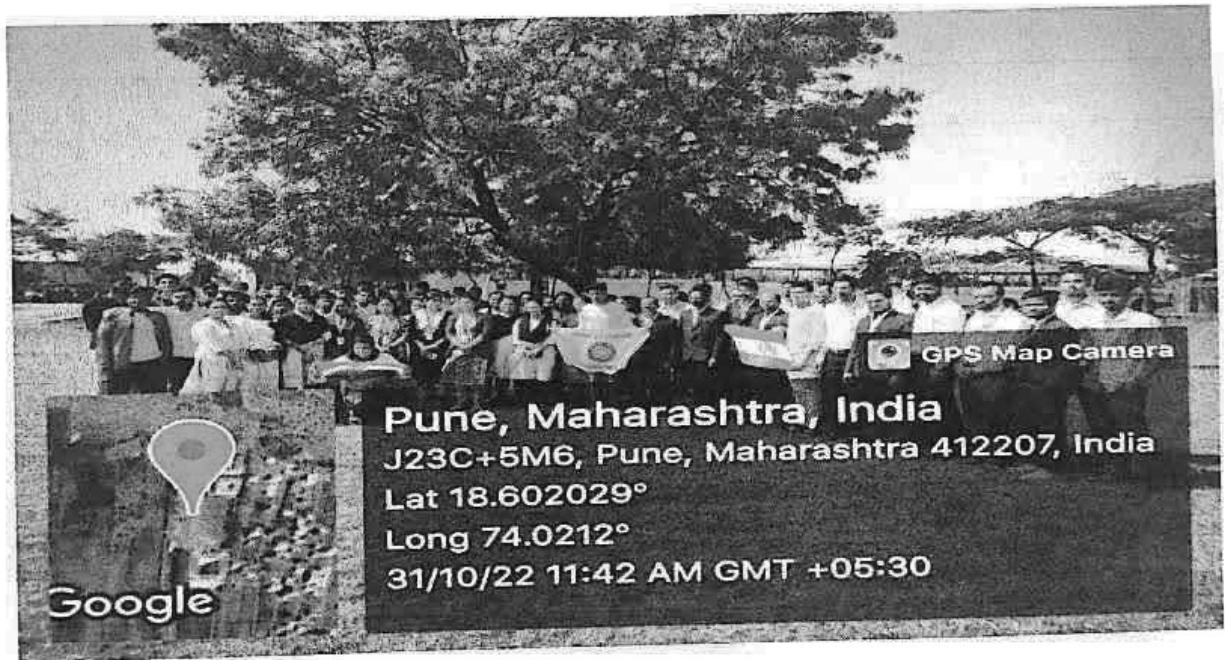


Fig.4. End Of the Rally
