“NSS Camp at Bakorigaon Village (Village adoption Program)”

NSS Stands for National Service Scheme. The main objective of the National Service Scheme as envisaged originally was service to the community, offered while undergoing instruction, in an educational institution. It was sought to arouse the social consciousness of students and provide them with the opportunity to work with the people around the educational campuses creatively and constructively and to put the education they received to concrete social use. It has been felt that the primary aim of the scheme is to enable the students to upgrade their personality and experience through community service.

The motto, i.e., the watchword of the NSS is “Not Me But You”. This expresses the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service and appreciation of the other man’s point of view and also to show consideration for fellow human beings. It underlines that the welfare of an individual is ultimately dependent on the welfare of the society as a whole. Shree Ramchandra College of Engineering has been in the forefront of NSS activities.

I. NSS Camp at Bakorigaon Village (Village adoption Program)

NSS unit of Shree Ramchandra college of Engineering, Lonikand Pune organized a special camp in the adopted village, from 17-03-2022 to 23-03-2022. This special camp was organized with the help of Gram Panchayat of Bakorigaon.. The Volunteers of the NSS unit performed many activities – awareness programs such as Electricity Safety, Digital Literacy , tree plantation, Health and Hygiene (open defecation), Gram Swachhata Abhiyan, Medical Camp by Diagnopein etc.

Day 1- (17th March 2022)

The forenoon session of the first day began with a Procession by volunteers in the village. Volunteers rallied into the streets of the village to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuing special camp programme in their village for a period of one week. This was followed by an inauguration Program held at Grampachayat of Bakorigaon Village. The programme was begun with lightening the lamp and NSS song. The chief guest was **Mr. Shantaram Ramdas Wargade** Sarpancha, Bakorigaon and **Mr. Bhausahieb Borade** Gramsevak, **Mr. Aanada Kamble** and **Mr. Swapnil Kamble** Socialist in Bakorigaon. Program was conducted by NSS Program officer of the unit Prof. Patil S.S. and he also expressed his opinion about the NSS camp. The function was attended by villagers. Village authorities welcomed the team of volunteers into their village and assured them all sorts of co-operation needed in making the NSS camp a success. On Afternoon of the First Day, Volunteers visited the people in their houses discussed about their needs and requirements and water conservation and water harvesting, energy conservation etc.

Volunteers created awareness through door to door campaign on cleanliness, spread of diseases, and importance of environment and judicious use of Electricity, water harvesting and importance of ground water. After taking dinner volunteers discussed the project agenda and activities of next day with NSS program officer and volunteers sang the NSS song and thus 1st day was concluded.

Day – 2& 3 (18th & 19th March 2022)

Second and third day was raised with **Shramdaan Programme**, about 25 volunteers divided themselves into sub groups and cleaned garden, Cremation ground, temple, lanes of the village etc. Volunteers removed dust heaps and cleared the stagnant drainage lines and passed a message on Cleanliness and hygiene and its benefits. 
Detailed Summary:-

The women from our colleges participate with a great fervor. The program proceeded with welcome speech by NSS Coordinator Prof. Shubhangi Arbale



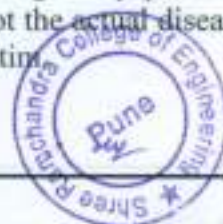


