A meeting of IQAC committee members was held on 12/05/2022 and commenced with the welcome note of the IQAC coordinator.

Following points were discussed

1. Confirmation of minutes of meetings of previous meeting

IQAC coordinator read all the minutes of previous meetings and unanimously, those were confirmed.

2. To submit Research proposals/conduct of workshop etc

It is discussed that the institute needs to strengthen the R&D activities. Encourage research potential of the teachers and motivate them to get major and minor research projects from government and other funding agencies. Arrange workshops on IPR, writing research Proposals. Also focus on various funding agencies for Major Research Grants. Final year and PG students are encouraged to apply for research grant, patents and publish articles in reputed journals. A budgetary provision of Rs 5.0 Lacks is made and all the members agreed with it.

3. To discuss about Academic Audit of current semester of AY 2022-23

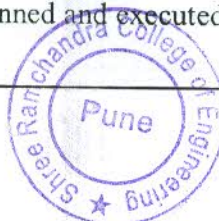
As a routine practice, academic audits are conducted and teachers are asked to arrange for practice sessions, conduct unit tests and provide additional remedial classes for slow learners. HODs to take necessary actions regarding the same.

4. To discuss on utility of ICT tools and FDPs

All faculties should use extensively various ICT Tools, for teaching learning process. They should attend various STTP/Workshops/Conferences for inputs on their area of interest. All the HOD's should conduct various Faculty and Staff Development Programs and motivate them to be the members of various technical organizations. All members readily agreed for the same.

5. To organize workshop on Competitive exams.

It is discussed that the students need to be prepared for competitive exams such as GATE/GRE/MPSC/UPSC etc for which MoU is signed with Un-Academy. In view of this, in the coming months these activities be planned and executed.




6. To see the progress related to NAAC cycle II


Institute is in a process of submitting SSR-II for NAAC Cycle-II, so all the criteria in-charges are doing their assigned work and the task shall be completed on or before end of June 2022. Members showed satisfaction with the current status of work.

7. To organize training sessions on python, AWS, Cyber security etc.

To equip students with industry needs and to make them employable, add on courses on emerging areas viz. Python, Azure, AWS, Cyber security etc be arranged and industry experts be engaged for the same. A budgetary provision for all such programs of Rs 6.0 Lacks is made. Members unanimously agreed on this.

Minutes of Meeting

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

A meeting of IQAC committee members was held on 10/11/2022 and commenced with the welcome note of the IQAC coordinator.

Following points were discussed

1. Confirmation of minutes of meetings of previous meeting

IQAC coordinator read all the minutes of previous meetings and unanimously, those were confirmed.

2. Preparation for NAAC Peer Team Visit

NAAC Peer Team visit was scheduled on 10th and 11th Nov. but since academic sessions of SE/TE/BE and admissions of FE are in progress, members unanimously decided to postpone the 'PTV' visit either in last week of Nov. 2022 or 1st week of Dec 2022. Principal was authorized to write a request letter to NAAC Bangalore.

The ongoing preparations for NAAC PTV are being continued and everything will be in place, in next few weeks.

3. To Analyze NIRF 2022, Introspection and further course of action for proposal of NIRF Ranking 2023.

The NIRF 2022, outcome discussed among the members. NIRF ranking is one of the key parameters, indicating improvements in quality initiatives of institute. The parameters are viz. "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Perception". All members agreed to do his/her best to improve upon academic and extracurricular activities and there upon help institute to get the higher ranking.

4. To arrange Student Induction Program (SIP) for newly admitted students and allied/related activities

A Schedule of student Induction Program (SIP) for 3 weeks (in a given A.Y.) for FE and DSE admitted students of AY 2022-23 is being prepared by FE Coordinator. Purpose of the SIP is to help newly admitted students to get adjusted and feel comfortable in the new environment, inculcate in them the ethics and culture of the institution, help them build bonds with other students and faculty members, and expose them to a sense of larger purpose and self exploration. All departments should plan visits to industries and industrial exhibitions to gain the practical knowledge. All HODs were requested to extend co-operation in this regard.



5. Regarding FDPs, STTP, workshop and Seminar

All departments have to conduct the faculty development program on emerging technologies to enhance their knowledge in their field of interest. They are further requested to plan and conduct STTPs, W/S, and Webinars etc.

6. To see the progress of courses under Kaushal Augmentation and Restructuring Mission of AICTE (KARMA) scheme

Under Model 2 KARMA scheme, the institute obtained approval for Certificate Courses in IoT, VLSI Design, Architecture and 2D Drafting with AUTOCAD. These courses are offered for Computer, Electronics/Electrical and Civil Engineering students respectively. All concerned faculties and HODs, to do the needful for smooth conduct of these courses.

7. AISHE and CII Academic survey participation AY 2022-23

It is unanimously agreed to participate in AISHE and CII academic survey, a step towards self assessment regarding "Quality Initiatives" of institute. Faculties Prof. G. T. Sawant and Prof. R B Pingale are authorized to be the coordinators for the said work.

8. Internship of faculty and students

Internship is helpful to overcome the gap between academic and industry requirement. The institutions always strive hard to renew education offered by them and to be as close as possible to the industrial requirement and expectations. In view of this, faculty and students must do the internship in industry. The internship experience will augment outcome based learning process. To help the student to equip with essential skills, the training of students in the industry is arranged. HODs are requested to sign MoUs with industries so that the faculty in-plant training, industrial visits, expert lectures etc be arranged. A budgetary provision of Rs 4 Lacks be made for the same.
